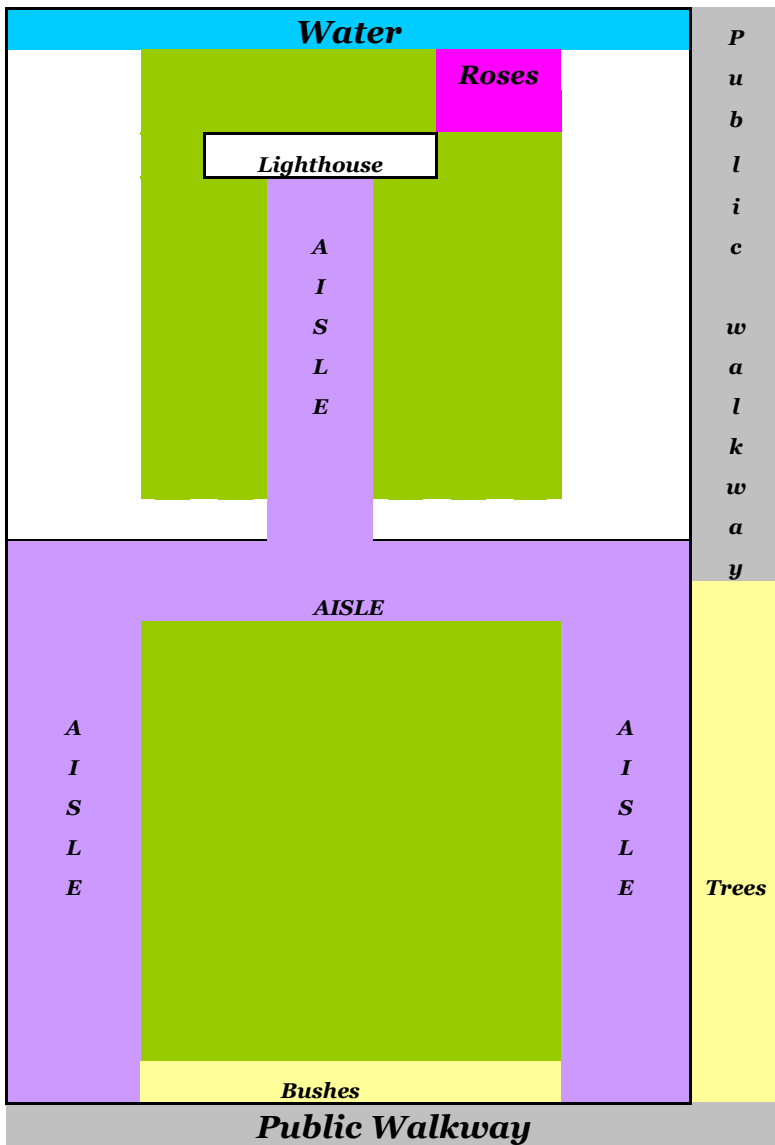




WEDDING CEREMONY INFORMATION

- Donation: The requested date and time will be confirmed upon receipt of the Agreement form and a \$300 tax deductible donation. If you are unable to hold your wedding ceremony due to inclement weather, a \$150 refund will be made. The remainder of the donation will be used for administrative costs. No refunds will be made for any other reason.
- Checks: Please make checks payable to: The Friends of Concord Point Lighthouse.
- You provide: All chairs, decorations, music, parking attendants, etc. Local rentals are available. We can help with addresses and telephone numbers.
- Decorations: You may place decorations on the same day as the wedding (bows, balloons, trellis, etc.). Chairs may be set up early if your wedding is scheduled to start right after the public tour hours. Please ask us for details.
- Petals, etc.: Please do not drop artificial flower petals, bird seed or rice during the ceremony. Real flower petals should not be left strewn around, as there may be a wedding to follow.
- Clean up: All decorations must be removed immediately following the ceremony. Rental equipment should be removed as soon as possible. ***The grounds should be left in the same condition as you found them.***
- Time: ***The Lighthouse is open to the public on weekends from April through October from 1 pm to 5 pm. Weddings may not be scheduled during these hours.*** The Lighthouse tower will be closed during your wedding. However, remember that this is a public area and cannot be sealed off from public access.
- Restrooms: Public restrooms are available a short distance from the Lighthouse at the City Pump Station on Lafayette Street. There are no facilities for dressing, etc.
- Electrical: An exterior 110v AC outlet is located at the base of the Lighthouse to the left of the entry door.
- Licensing: Concord Point Lighthouse is not involved in the licensing. For additional information see this site: <http://www.brides.com/local/maryland/article/2793>.
- Space: A diagram is attached showing the space we have available for your ceremony. Please do not set up chairs in other grassy areas, as we do not have permission to use that land.
