***Save The Cannon!***

Once again the Friends are taking on an important restoration project. At the base of the Lighthouse sits the Cannon Memorial in honor of John O'Neill, a War of 1812 hero and our first keeper at Concord Point. The 1812 cannon memorial was dedicated at the Lighthouse ceremony on November 14, 1914 attended by Ms. Naomi Tydings and Ms. Esther Jackson, both great, great granddaughters of John O'Neill. By 1924, the automated Lighthouse grounds were off limits to the public and the memorial was moved by horse and wagon to the new Tydings Park. In 1983, the Friends were able to return the monument to the newly restored Lighthouse where it is today.

We recently learned that both the monument and cannon are in dire need of conservation work. The cannon will be treated at the Maryland Archeological Conservation Laboratory and the monument will be cleaned and treated in situ by a conservator. This work is costly, but will preserve the monument for future generations.
